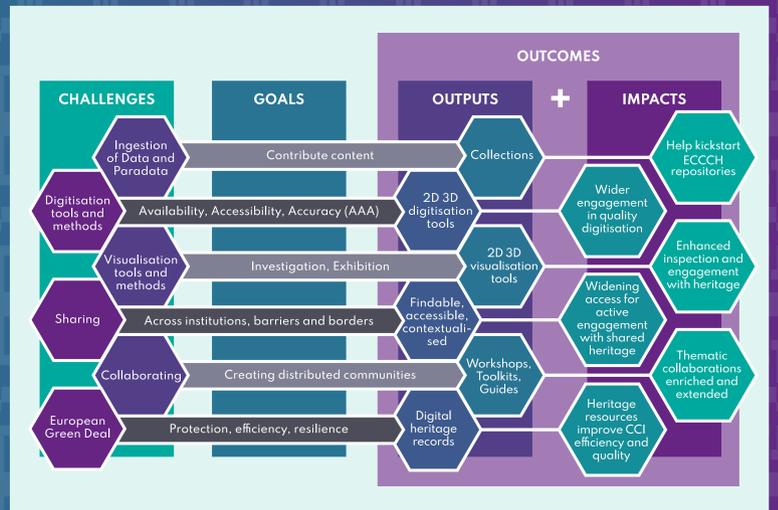

HERITALISE transforms cultural heritage (CH) documentation and preservation through advanced digitization and AI tools, revealing both visible and hidden CH features.

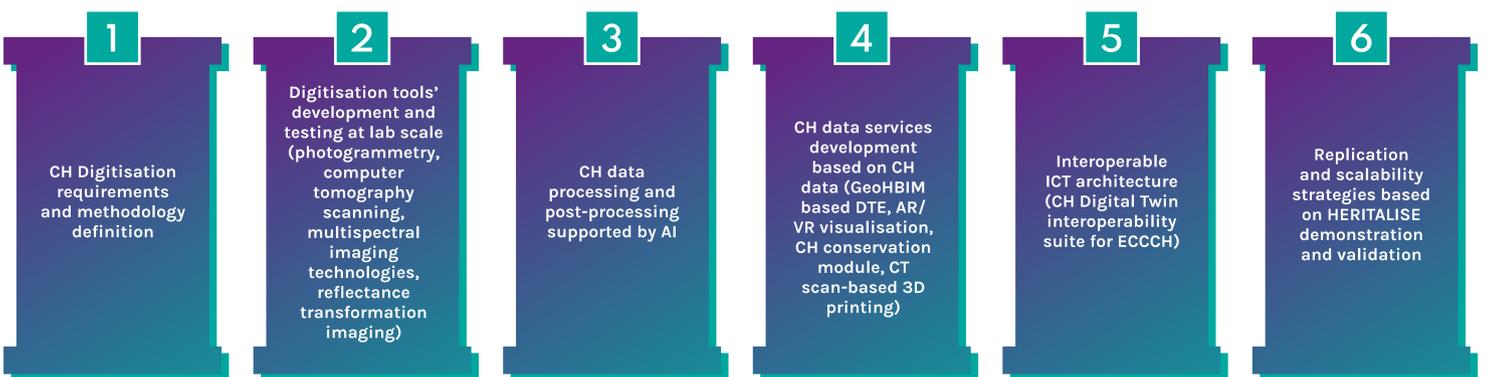
Key Highlights:

Efficiency & Innovation: Aims to offer 70% more access to a FAIR-based ecosystem, cut costs by 50%, and create authentic digital twins for tourism, education, and European identity.

Sustainability Focus: Supports the EU Green Deal, remote collaboration, and impactful exhibits, reducing travel and advancing climate goals.
